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## ADMISSION POLICY

The School Governing Body notes the following legislative framework relating to the admissions of learners to **LABIANCE PRIMARY SCHOOL**:

- The Constitution
- The National Policy Act
- The South African Schools Act (SASA)
- Norms and Standards of Funding
- Regulations relating to minimum uniform Norms and Standards for Public schools infrastructure
- Immigration Act
- Refugees Act
- Admissions of learners to public schools Provincial Acts
- Promotion of Administrative Act (PAJA)
- Aliens Control Act

**LABIANCE PRIMARY** is a public school, having juristic personality by virtue of the provisions of Sections 15 of the South African Schools Act, No 84 of 1996.

**LABIANCE PRIMARY** is an English-medium institution equipped with human resources to cater primarily for those learners whose mother tongue or chosen Language of Learning and Teaching is English.

**LABIANCE PRIMARY** only accepts learners turning 6 in their Grade R year. The School follows WCED policy with regard to Grade R: (a) Grade R is not compulsory and (b) a maximum of 30 learners per class is allowed.

Unless and until the HOD, after consultation with the SGB, decides otherwise, the natural feeder areas of **LABIANCE PRIMARY** is **Labiance, Shirley Park, Loumar, Marinda Park, Sonnekuil, Soneike, Sirocco Village and Glenhaven.**

The following preference will be afforded to applications:

- Siblings of learners already enrolled at **LABIANCE PRIMARY**.
- Those in respect of learners bona fide (genuinely) residing with their parents (as defined in SASA) within the natural feeder area of the school, as stated above.
- Those in respect of learners bona fide (genuinely) residing with their parents (as defined in SASA) within the natural feeder area of the school, as stated above, and whose mother tongue is the medium of tuition of the School.
- Those in respect of learners bona fide (genuinely) residing with their parents (as defined in SASA) within the natural feeder area of the school, as stated above, and whose chosen medium of tuition is the medium of tuition of the School.
- Learners residing outside the natural feeder area (stated above), and whose mother tongue or chosen medium of tuition is the medium of the School, depending on the capacity of the School.

The following factors were considered in determining the School's capacity:

- That learners' best interest have preference
- The number of educators available
- The space available for administrative needs
- The number of appropriate classes available
- Space needed for sports, cultural and recreational activities
- The available space in the current Information Centre, Technology class and school hall.
- The sanitary facilities available
- Parking facilities
- Safety Measurements
- The maximum number of learners permitted per class
- Internationally recognised best practice with regard to class size in order to deliver effective and efficient quality education.

The SGB requires the School Principal to obtain the following information from the applicant:

- The name, residential address, work address and all contact details of each biological parent.
- The learner's birth certificate.
- A copy of the ID document confirming the identity of both parents.
- A municipal account or affidavit to verify the place of residence of a learner and his/her parents.
- A certified copy of any Court Order confirming guardianship or custody or any similar right of the person claiming parental right.
- Proof of vaccinations (clinic card). (Grade R and Grade 1 learners only)

- The most recent progress report of the prospective learner from his/her previous school (if any).

The SGB of **LABIANCE PRIMARY** considers itself to be in duty bound to always work in the best interest of all learners, to protect the educators, learners and non-educators of the School from physical or mental violence to the full extent of its power to do so, and to foster the physical, mental and moral welfare of learners.
